<b>Application</b>	Add <b>COELAN® Colour Paste</b> in the prescribed mixing rate to the liquid PU resin and stir the two components homogeneously and free from reams by means of a paddle or a low running agitator (max. 300 RPM). Please mind that the different colours have a different opacity. To reach an adequate opacity, you might need several working steps.
